

Postcards [Leather] From Dorset Part II

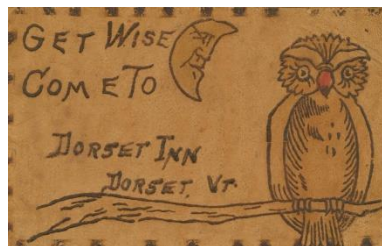

Leather postcards enjoyed a brief popularity, which peaked from 1903 – 1908. These cards may have been mass-produced on basic templates somewhere, but we do not know those particulars. Only one of these postcards was ever sent, the “Mary” card, is addressed to Miss Ada Lilley of Dorset Vermont, with an April 5, 1907 Brattleboro Vermont postmark.
